

NORTHLAND NORTH SHORE CONTEST
MONDAY the 21st of OCTOBER 2013
2000-2100HRS NZ LOCAL TIME IN TWO HALF HOUR PERIODS

BANDS: 80 Metres (3.530 to 3.600MHz suggested) and 2 Metres.

ELIGIBLE STATIONS

All stations must have a single operator who **MUST** be a member of one or more of the following NZART branches:

78 Far North, 84 Bay of Islands, 28 Whangarei,

71 Rodney, 80 Hibiscus Coast, 29 North Shore.

Contacts within or between these branches are the only ones eligible for points.

Mobile/portable operation is permitted.

QSOs

Stations may contact each other in each half hour period in up to four different modes:

1. 80 metres phone
2. 80 metres CW
3. 2 metres phone simplex
4. 2 metres phone via repeater (only the Far North, Bay of Islands, Whangarei, Brynderwyn and Rodney repeaters may be used.)

“Twice running” QSOs are permitted.

CONTEST EXCHANGE

RS(T) report and 2 digit serial number/branch. (E.g. 5901/28).

POINTS

80m phone = 1; 80m CW = 3; 2m repeater = 1; 2m simplex = 3

There are no multipliers or bonus points.

LOGS TO SHOW

Date, time, frequency/mode (e.g., 80CW- 2m repeater etc), numbers sent, numbers received, and points claimed. On a separate sheet, your callsign, name and postal address, email address, branch name and number, and a declaration that the contest rules and Radio Regs have been complied with.
