Repeater - Trustee's Report and Activities

 Repeater is working well all the time and didn't show any weakness during Thursdays' 730-Net.

Diplexer / spare Repeater:

Ross came up with the idea that we should use the spare repeater and diplexer as a mobile and temporary repeater, e.g. used for AREC.

Ross found out that NZART provided 5 frequencies that can be used for special purpose licences. The only condition to fulfil is to assure that there is no interferences with other clubs and users. The frequencies that can be used for special purpose are (MHz):

• Is enjoying his new iCom7300. Commenting that this rig has a spectrum scope as well. Sounds like easy DX hunting!




Ross – ZL1DRB:

 Brought his RaspberryPi 3 along for a demonstration. The Pi was configured and loaded with software so it could act as a frequency sweep generator, covering for up to 230MHz.

When it was in operation we could clearly hear the sweep with a handheld eventhough the Pi had no aerial connected. The output just came out of one of its digital pins.

The Pi he used was a Pi-3, Bv1.2 (2015) running on Raspberry Linux 4.9.24-v7.



Sandy – ZL1ZL3AXL:

• Sandy had about 4 handhelds with him and we could provide him with plenty of new QSO's on VHF. **ZL3AXL** is now a well-known call sign amongst us already ©.

Gavin – ZL1GAM:
